#### A Moment of Madness - Ford Consul ute

In December 2022 I was cruising Facebook when an old 1958 Consul Ute came up which sparked my interest. On investigation and a trip to Benalla, I became the new owner. Having never done a vehicle before, I got inspired to get it functional. Little did I know the amount of work involved.

On returning home a good wash removed most of the lichen that had grown. As it was sitting outside without a windscreen for around 20+ years, it revealed the rust that had moved in (I think I must have had a blind eye when I first had a look at it).

Removal of all mechanicals revealed the state of body work and under panels (more rust). I then decided to turn the vehicle upside down to attack he underbelly (Oh Boy!). Replacement commenced – large section of floor panelling (firewall to diff), fuel tank rebuilt, spare tyre carrier, chassis rails renewed, sills replaced, fuel and brake lines renewed and front end rebushed.

Turned upright only to start on more rust – panels/doors, tail door, entire dash replaced, tub floor. Into the mechanicals – bearings, brakes, windows, rubbers and wiring. New pistons, water pump, clutch and lots of other bits and pieces.

It is amazing to me how many times you have to do the same thing (at least 3) as something will go wrong. Something unrelated to what you are working on will fail/rust off/break/turn or simply laugh at you if looked at.

In all just on three sheets of 8' x 4' of steel have disappeared into the vehicle (not sure where).

Thanks to Jim for the engine rebuild and Ross for the roadworthy. I final hit the road 18 months later only to go for a short test drive to run out of fuel with a passer by stopping to help. Just happened to be Carol, so I got rubbished (the fuel gauge has now been repaired).

In all it was a project I have enjoyed and hope to cruise the countryside with the picnic basket in the future.

#### 3. YOUR SIGNATURE

Don't forget as the permit holder you need to sign your renewal notice.

Upon renewal, please photocopy your renewal form for club records and ensure the club has hard copy photographs of your vehicle. Required <u>date stamped</u> photos are:

- front - rear - driving position (side on, door open)

- passenger side - driver side - body and engine number stampings and plates Permit registration renewals are to be signed by club signatories at <u>club meetings only</u>. Please do not approach them at their workplace or home, except in a pre-arranged emergency situation.

*Club Signatories:* Ross Watson or Rod Boreham (<u>club meetings only</u>) Please remember that club permit holders must always remain financial members of the club. Yearly membership fees need to be received no later than June 30.
